

# Leticia Ramos

b. 1976, Santo Antônio da Patrulha, Brazil  
lives and works in São Paulo



Leticia Ramos explores the limits of the production and exegesis of analog images through photographic and film works, which she also develops into installations, objects, publications, and performances. Her practice is directed toward the aesthetic intersections between the documental and the fictional, occurring between natural and imaginary landscapes, between the discourses of historical records and those of invented characters, while simultaneously exploring the relationship between graphical memory and the nature of the abstract and spectral.

Using rigorous technical and formal procedures as a point of departure, the artist emulates aspects of scientific expeditions to guide us along ambiguous and atemporal objects and themes. In this sense, she builds inventive photographic apparatuses – such as cameras, models, and sets – to think about the use of these devices as elements of the speculation, representation, and production of geographic and poetic terrains.

Patricia Leite and Letícia Ramos present images and situations that represent or evoke skies and astronomical phenomena. The works include paintings, photographs, videos, and an installation that features clouds, constellations, the moon, eclipses, twilights, and planispheres. Some of the pieces were created in 2017 and 2018, but the majority were conceived this year, especially for this exhibition, either individually or collaboratively. This marks the first time they have joined forces for a collaborative project. One aspect of this partnership that immediately sparks curiosity is the grouping of works and trajectories that, at first glance, seem very distinct.


Leticia Ramos contends that reality is a patchwork of variable and fleeting contingencies. Her work suggests that the answer to our woes cannot be found in the realm of appearances but in an occult cosmological rationale that unites us with other beings and other times. Working with photography as a way of capturing the ineffable and creating worlds, Ramos reiterates that the only possible solution against the emergence of the apocalyptic sphere is a structural shift in the way we understand and engage with reality. The future looks increasingly less like the past; however, we continue to believe in weather forecasts and technocratic rhetoric.





The first solo exhibition in the United States by Brazilian artist Leticia Ramos. Her complex images synthesize technique and illusion by exploring the limits of analog photography. For Ramos, Photography is a form of chemical mechanical magic and relies on empirical research and experimentation to create her work, driving towards an aesthetic intersection between the documentable and fictional. Resiliency and Reverberation is comprised of several bodies of work from her recent projects, Resistance of the Body and Universal History of Earthquakes, each examining perceived realities, ruptures and modes of production.


The collection of works by Letícia Ramos presented in Planisphere have close links with adventures that science and science fiction have embraced throughout their existence, such as the birth of Planet Earth, the origins of life and theories around the hypothesis of chaos. We know that in the Theory of Chaos , the smallest noise at the onset of any event can drastically change the development of future events. In line with the theory, the idea of unpredictability and non-apparent order guides the research on this topic, where a tap dripping and a dog's heartbeat have the same rhythm of the sound produced by an exploding star in space.






The artist has been investigating the socioeconomic, psychological and political causes and effects of earthquakes since she was awarded the Fundación Botín Visual Art Grant in 2016. The departure point for her research is the earthquake that struck Lisbon in 1775. Seen as one of history's most intense earthquakes, the event had a tremendous impact on 18th century Portuguese society – and, consequently, also on its colonies. The cataclysm endorsed many mythical and religious interpretations of the calamity that followed.










Leticia Ramos, *Bicho Azul*, 2024, c-print,







Leticia Ramos, *whitenoise*, 2023, silver print photogram,








Leticia Ramos, *PHOTODRAWING*, 2020, photogram / silver print,




