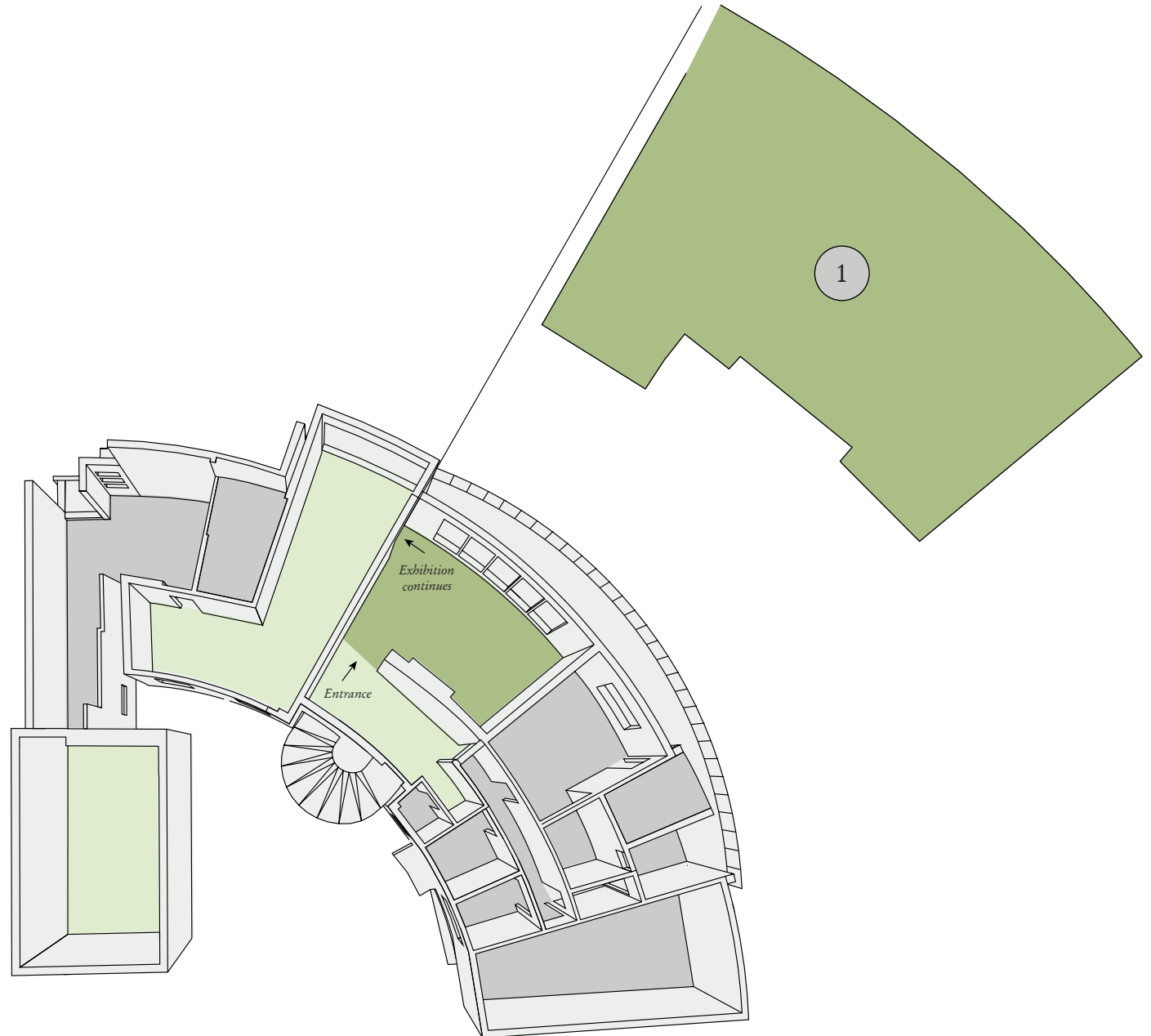

1. *Rima*, 2025

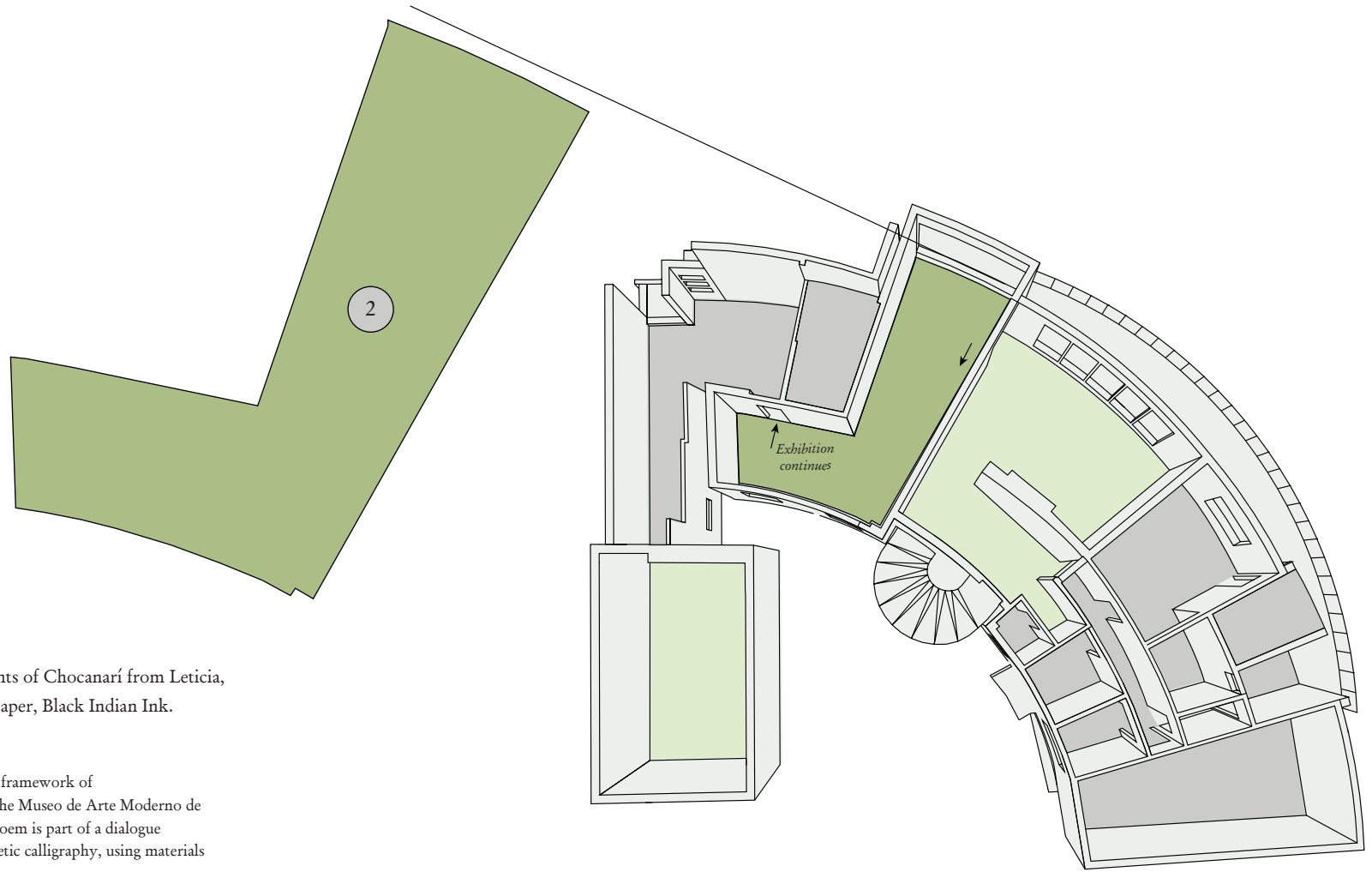

Context

Amazonas River (2025) was created within the framework of Correspondences, an installation presented at the Museo de Arte Moderno de Medellín in January 2025. The writing of the poem is part of a dialogue between Amazonian pictorial tradition and poetic calligraphy, using materials with strong symbolic and cultural significance.

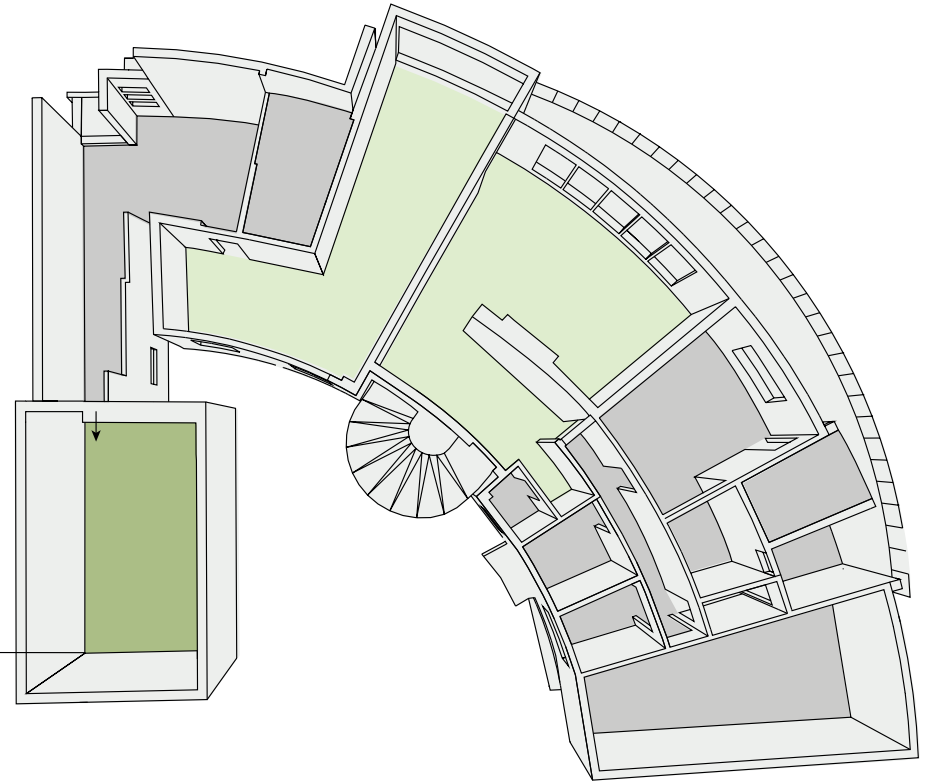
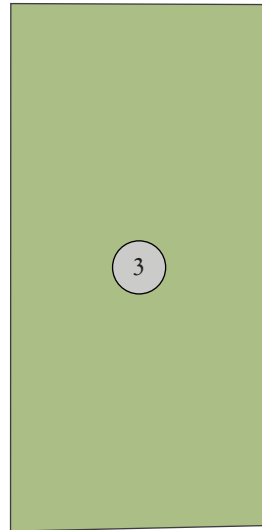
Research and Tradition
